

REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

RFP No. 2019-01

The City of Mercedes will accept Requests for Proposals for Engineering Services for roadway Improvements to Mile 1 East from Business 83 to Mile 8 North in the City of Mercedes until **10:00 a.m.** (Standard Time – Daylight Savings Time) on **Thursday, December 19, 2019** at the Mercedes City Hall in the office of the City Manager located at 400 S. Ohio Avenue, Mercedes, Texas 78570. This project is funded by the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) and the City of Mercedes. Envelopes must be clearly marked “**RFP No. 2019-01 Engineering Services for Mile 1 East Improvements: Right-of Way for the City of Mercedes – Phase II and III**”. The RFP packet instructions may be retrieved via the City’s main website’s link (www.cityofmercedes.com under the Bids/Contracts Section), or picked up in the Office of the Mercedes City Secretary, 400 S. Ohio, Mercedes, Texas 78570.

This project is a Coordinated Border Infrastructure Category 10, off-system project. The project will reconstruct and widen Mile 1 East Road from Business 83 to Mile 8 Road to a four-lane urban facility.

Professional Services firms must be able to provide all aspects of professional services work needed for project completion such as roadway engineering, schematics, surveying, mapping, right-of-way acquisition, subsurface and geotechnical engineering and may include further preparation or modification of existing environmental assessment documents/study’s. The City will utilize the fixed-rate contract method for this project.

Request for Proposals received after the deadline shall not be considered and will be returned unopened. The City of Mercedes reserves the right to postpone, to accept, or to reject any or all proposals.

Proposals may be held by the City of Mercedes for a period not to exceed thirty (30) days from the date of the opening for the purpose of reviewing and investigating qualifications prior to making a recommendation to the Mercedes City Commission for award.
