1.) CALL MEETING TO ORDER.

Mayor Hinojosa called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm.

2.) ESTABLISH QUORUM.

All members of the commission were present.

3.) INVOCATION.

Commissioner Gomez led the Invocation

4.) PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE.

Commissioner Tovar led the Pledge of allegiance.

5.) OPEN FORUM-

Carlos Figueroa of Waste Connections of Texas addressed the commission regarding complaints about the solid waste service during the transition from another company. Petra Vidales spoke about a rude comment she overheard on a recording of a previous Commission meeting and the lack of work being done to fix damaged roads in her neighborhood. City Manager Ricardo Garcia informed the Commission of the results of a federal audit conducted at the Mercedes Police Department. He said the staff should be commended for all of their hard work in making sure the department was in complete compliance. Brian Acosta of the Mercedes Little League addressed the Commission about the need for more fences around the baseball fields to ensure the safety of all the children and families that participate in the youth baseball and softball leagues. Jesus Noriega of TxDot updated the Commission on the progress of several projects in and around Mercedes.

6.) CONSENT AGENDA (ORDINANCE NO. 98-21):

7.) DISCUSSION AND FORMAL ACTION APPROVING CONTRACT WITH GIGNAC FOR ENGINEER/ARCHITECT SERVICES FOR THE DOME SAFE SHELTER PROJECT. (#2013/01/15B)

Commissioner Tovar made a motion to approve the contract with Gignac for Engineer/Architect services for the dome safe shelter project (#2013/01/15B). The motion was seconded by Commissioner Rodriguez and passed with Mayor Pro-Tem Garcia voting against.

8.) DISCUSSION AND FORMAL ACTION APPROVING REQUEST TO SOLICIT BIDS FOR TWO RECYCLING TRAILERS WITH FUNDING FROM LOWER RIO GRANDE DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL SOLID WASTE GRANT # 13-21-G03.

The City Received a grant in the amount of \$19,970 to help fund the purchase of the new recycling trailers. The city has had great success with the single recycling trailer currently in use. Commissioner

Rodriguez made a motion to solicit bids for two recycling trailers with funding from Lower Rio Grande Development Council solid waste grant #13-21-G03. The motion was seconded by Mayor Pro-Tem Garcia and passed unanimously.

9.) DISCUSSION AND FORMAL ACTION APPROVING REQUEST TO ADVERTISE FOR CONSTRUCTION BIDS FOR 17TH STREET UTILITY RELOCATION.

Commissioner Rodriguez made a motion to approve advertising for construction bids for 17th street utility relocation. Commissioner Tovar seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.
