1.) CALL MEETING TO ORDER.

Mayor Hinojosa called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM.

A Quorum of the Commission was present.

3.) INVOCATION.

Mayor Pro-Tem Gomez made the invocation.

4.) PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE.

Commissioner Guajardo led the pledge of allegiance.

5.) OPEN FORUM-

City Manager Ricardo Garcia announced that the City's Fitch credit rating had been upgrades to A+ with a stable outlook.

Ramon Mejia addressed the commission regarding several matters including city leadership, a shooting incident involving police officers, speeding in his neighborhood and government transparency.
