## 1) CALL MEETING TO ORDER

Mayor Hinojosa called the meeting to order at 1:00 PM

### 2) ESTABLISH QUORUM

#### 4) PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

## 5) DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION TO APPROVE THE PURCHASE OF A 2019 AMBULANCE FOR COVID RESPONSE FROM SOUTHWAST AMBULANCE SALES.

Fire Chief Campos updated the Commission of the impact COVID has had on the City of Mercedes and continued on the need to continuously provide great service to the Citizens of Mercedes. Fire Chief Campos informed the Commission of the call volume for EMS Services.

After a brief discussion, Commissioner Hernandez made a motion to approve item 5. Mayor Pro-Tem Villarreal seconded the motion. Upon a called vote, the item passed unanimously.

# 6) DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION TO APPROVE THE PURCHASE OF 6 SELF-CONTAINED BREATING APPARATUS FOR COVID-19 USAGE FROM HEAT SAFETY EQUIPMENT, LLC.

Fire Chief Campos informed the Commission of the necessity for the 6 Air Packs and stated they would be placed on the 3 ambulances. The funding would come from the CARES Act and may take 3 to 4 weeks to arrive. After a brief discussion, Mayor Pro-Tem Villarreal made a motion to approve item 6. Commissioner Hernandez seconded the motion. Upon a called vote, the item passed unanimously.

## 7) DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION TO APPROVE THE PURCHASE OF 10 PORTABLE RADIOS FROM TRI-COUNTY COMMUNICATIONS.

Fire Chief Campos stated that the portable radios would allow each firefighter to have one assigned. This would help from cross contamination of COVID-19.

Commissioner Benavidez made a motion to approve item 7. Mayor Pro-Tem Villarreal seconded the motion. Upon a called vote, the motion passed unanimously.
