No candidate received the majority vote in Place 1 or Place 3, therefore, a runoff between Melissa "Melly" Rincon and Jacob C. Howell will be held for Place 1 and David Garza and Joe Martinez for Place 3. Election day for the runoff is scheduled for December 8th at the Mercedes Civic Center.
